

Five Stripe Program

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The Five Stripe System is used to motivate and reward children for their hard work and good behavior. The program is designed to challenge a child and to help them better understand goal setting, achieving and develop good habits.

There are 5 stripes: Blue, Black, Red, Green and Yellow. Each stripe has a different meaning and different knowledge that must be accumulated to earn that stripe and required to earn certain stripes in order to test for their belt test. Once student complete any stripe requirements, have your child turn in to their instructor before the testing date. Students who earns all five stripes they will receive a trophy at the belt ceremony day as a reward.

Blue Stripe

Color Belts & Little Tigers student

Blue Stripe is awarded for reading five books that are at or above the student's reading level. The purpose is to encourage students to read and gain knowledge. If the student is reading a lengthy chapter book, it can count for more than one book

Black Belts student

Black Belt's Blue Stripe is awarded for reading five books that are at or above the student's reading level with a one page summary for each book. The purpose is to help build greater reading comprehension and to increase the students' writing skills.

Black Stripe

Color Belts & Little Tigers student

Black Stripe is awarded for completing a certain number of chores at home. The purpose is to help build discipline and responsibility at home. The parents determine which chores the child should perform for credit. After they completed Stripe requirement, however, it is a good idea for them to keep working on their chores.

Black Belts student

Black Stripe is awarded for completing a certain amount of community service. The purpose of the community service is to help the community and build a sense of responsibility and discipline.

Red Stripe

Little Tigers student

Red Stripe is awarded for completing their coloring book to the best of the students' ability. For children, part of building strong character is through school work, and the coloring packet is designed to help your child learn to associate actions with names along with numbers and alphabets recognition, all through the fun of coloring.

Color Belts & Black Belts student

Red Stripe is awarded for a well maintained or improved school progress. The purpose is to help them excel at school. This report focuses not only on grades, but also on if the student is listening and following their teacher and demonstrating good manners with their classmates. The student's school teacher and/or parents should fill out their Red Stripe card.

Green Stripe

Color Belts & Little Tigers & Black Belts student

The green stripe focuses on taekwondo curriculum. This stripe is awarded by their instructor in class. Once the student learns the curriculum they must be able to perform it from memory without mistake and help.

Yellow Stripe

Color Belts & Little Tigers & Black Belts student

Yellow Stripe is awarded to students who consistently demonstrate good behavior at home, school, and public. The purpose is to promote consistent, good behavior in all areas of your child's life. The Yellow Stripe card should be filled out by the parents. The Taekwondo Instructor will then look at the student's behavior and then make a decision regarding that student's Yellow Stripe.
